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In the Name of God Amen:
I Henry Iker of the state of North Carolina
Lincoln County: Being very sick and Weak
in Body: but of perfect mind and Memory
thanks be given unto God: Calling unto mind the
mortality of my Body: Do make and ordain this
My Last will and Testament; in the manner
following: I Recommend my soul into the
Hand of Almighty God that hee it, and my
Body I Recommend to the Earth to be Buried in
Good Christian Buriall at the Discretion
of my Executors. And as Touching such worldly
Estate wherewith it has pleased God to Bless
me in this Life I heere Devise and Dispose
of the Same in the following manner and
Form -

First I heere and heere unto Elisabeth my Dear
beloved Wife three Beddes and Bed states and
all the Pewder we possess at this Time -
one Birch Iron Pot and one Two Gallon pott
Two springing wheelles: one Chest and Two
Covers one Red and the other Black with
a white Back; and also one Brazen Warfe
and a white mare and heere for the same
also one Plain and Irons and Eleven Hates
of Haggas: and my saddle and all the harness
what is on the Plantation: at this Time
said Elisabeth my wife shall Putt to her
and our Childrens use: and Twelf Hacks
of Sheep where they may pick them out of
Twenty fawcetts that is for her and the Children
and all the said wee heere at this Time
and one Leese Bridel: and all the Bookes
wee heere at this Time for said Elisabeth
our Children

and I also order in this my Last will &
Testament that Elisabeth my wife shall
have Peaceable Possession on the Plantation
wherein we now Live: as Long as shee
is a widow: butt if shee gets married or Dies
then said Land is to Come to my Two sons
Dannell and Henry, I her: to be Equally Div
I order to ^{my} Daughter Janney one Dark Brown
Cow and Calf: and to ^{my} Daughter Catharine
one Pitted Cow - and I also order to my son
Dannell my ~~Electre~~: and one Acre to my son
Henry -

and I Likewise constitute Make and order
Lawrence I her and William Deal the
Sole Executors of this my Last will and
Testament for Witnesses whereof I have here-
unto set my hand and seal this ~~first~~ ^{first} Day
thirty first Day of July 1800
