Know all men by these present that I, Joshua Harshaw, have this day sold a certain piece of land unto Martha Nogle and the heirs of her body, said land in district No. 63, beginning on a black oak on the east side of the Unicorn Road and runs north forty one poles to a chestnut; then west thirty one poles to a black oak; then north one hundred and ninety poles to a pine; then west sixty eight poles to a hickory; then south 45 west one hundred poles to a pine; then south one hundred and one poles to a pine crossing the road at fifty poles; then 63 east one hundred

and twenty eight poles to the beginning, lying 14 poles west the Unicoy Road from the corner of No. 52, containing one hundred and eighty seven acres, more or less. N.B. there is seven acres that is reserved as long as they hold Camp-Meeting there, the said Harshaw is to receive one hundred and eighty dollars for the said lands from the said purchaser all in the state and County aforesaid, the said Purchaser pays a portion down and has filed her notes for the balance. N.B. all the mineral interest is excepted, this August the 6th, 1853. The condition of the above obligation is such the said Harshaw binds himself, his heirs and assigns jointly and severally and firmly by these presents unto Martha Nogle, her heirs and assigns in the penal sum of three hundred and sixty dollars, now the condition of the above bond is such at the payment of said notes if the said Harshaw makes or causes to be made a good and sufficient title to said land the above to be void, or otherwise to remain in full force and virtue in law. The mineral excepted however N.B. the mineral interest to be equally divided between the parties.
